THE MAIN DIRECTIONS OF THE CONFERENCE

2. Mechanisms of epileptogenesis, traditional and prospective targets of action of antiepileptic drugs;
3. Preclinical studies of drugs with anticonvulsant activity;
4. Non-antiepileptic drugs in the epilepsy treatment;
5. Phytotherapy in epileptology;
6. Clinical epileptology;
7. Market analysis, pharmacoepidemiological, pharmaco-economic, and pharmacovigilance aspects of antiepileptic drug use.

PUBLICATION OF CONFERENCE MATERIALS

Proceedings of the conference will be published in the book of abstracts "**Antiepileptic drugs: from molecular design to clinical application**".

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The template is attached, the complete guidelines are as follows:

- the font is Times New Roman, the font size is 14 with all margins of 2 cm, the line spacing is 1.0, spacing before and after paragraph – 0 pt (absent), main line spacing – 1,25 cm, the thesis/article should fit 1–4 full pages;
- the headline indicates the name of the abstract (first line, bold, capitals), names and initials of authors, separated with commas (second line, bold, italics), complete name of authors' affiliation, city, country (third line, bold);
- the sections are as follows: introduction (the relevance and the aim of the study are indicated briefly), materials and methods (patients and methods), results, conclusions, and references list (if needed);
- words abbreviation are included only with primary indication of complete name, units of measurement are given according to the International System of Units (SI);
- in order to maintain the correct structure of the text after formatting, the authors are kindly asked to use non-breaking space (key combination Ctrl + Shift + Space) instead of the usual space in such cases: before and after all mathematical symbols (+ , - , : , × , ± , < > etc.), before doses indication (ml/kg, g , mg/kg, U, IU etc.), concentration values (g/l, mmol/l etc.), time intervals (months, s, min), percent (%), temperature measures (° C), other physical and mathematical values as well as names and initials;
- hyphenation (both manual and automatically made) should not be applied in the abstract
- numeric ranges should be given with dashes – (without any spaces, for example 4.3–4.7 mmol/l), but not with a hyphen, hyphen with spaces should not be used instead of dash);
- after the main text, if necessary, a numbered list of references is given in the form of a full bibliographic description of the works in alphabetical order, within the text the references are given in the form of the number of the source in the list in square brackets
